The Roots N Blues N BBQ Festival Announces Second Round of Artists for 2014

COLUMBIA, MO- Thumper Entertainment continues to announce artists for The 2014 Roots N Blues N BBQ Festival presented by U.S Cellular®. This is the second artist announcement for the 2014 Festival held September 26-28 at Stephens Lake Park.

Added to the previously announced round of 2014 performers, Philadelphia native, Amos Lee will offer up his folk, rock, and soul talents at the festival. Los Lobos, a group inspired by traditional Spanish and Mexican music will bring a blast of Tex-Mex and country roots. Progressive bluegrass band with a touch of outlaw country, Blackberry Smoke will be performing, as well as gritty soul band, St. Paul & The Broken Bones. Others include The Preservation Hall Jazz Band, down-home story telling folk band, JJ Grey & Mofro, the St. Louis-based American songwriter, Jay Farrar with Gary Hunt, and a Bluegrass sound from Hot Rize. Plus, don't miss performances by Festival alumni Tj Wheeler and Chump Change.

Previously announced performers for 2014 will be The Avett Brothers, bringing a sound all their own, with influences from nearly every music genre. American songwriting treasure, John Prine and country legend, Rosanne Cash, daughter of Johnny Cash, will also be headlining the event. Other artists include the quirky Lake Street Dive, Mexo-Americana sounds of David Wax Museum, Jason Isbell formerly of The Drive By Truckers, Minnesota roots music hybrid Trampled By Turtles, two-man thump-machine The Flood Brothers, and The Hooten Hallers bringing loud Blues and hillybilly Soul. Catch additional performances by giant puppet troupe, The Astral Gypsies and hoop-dancers, The Hulagans. The 2014 Stage Schedule is set to be released on Wednesday, June 25.

This 3-day festival will be held at Stephens Lake Park and begins Friday, September 26 and will run through Sunday, September 28, 2014.
